**What does Gift Aid mean for Ronald McDonald House?**

Gift Aid donations are treated as having had basic rate tax deducted, which we can reclaim. For every £1 you donate, we will be able to claim back 28p from the government.

**What does Gift Aid mean for you?**

By signing to Gift Aid your donation, you are declaring that you are a UK taxpayer, and have paid enough income/capital gains tax in that year to cover what RMH will claim back.

If you are a higher rate taxpayer, you may also be entitled to claim relief on your Gift Aided donations. For further information, please contact your local Tax Office.

1. As your declaration covers donations you may make in the future please notify us if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force
  2. If you cancel your Gift Aid Declaration it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
  3. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that RMH will reclaim on your donations in the tax year - currently 28p for every £1 donated - If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax equal to that reclaimed please notify RMH.
  3. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
